#### IMPORTANT UPCOMING MAINTENANCE WORKS

Cambridgeshire County Council in conjunction with our appointed contractors will be undertaking planned carriageway maintenance works (resurfacing) on both North End & Freedom Bridge Roundabout (RAB) (A1101), Wisbech. There will also be some additional works to the inner ring of the roundabout. Attached is an overview of the works area for your viewing along with the proposed diversion routes.

Resurfacing works will commence at North End, Wisbech first. The works will require a full road closure to deliver the works safely and effectively. All works will be undertaken at night to prevent disruption and further to this being Sunday working only. Due to being adjacent to Asda Superstore the working hours will reflect their closing hours.

Please be aware that these resurfacing works on North End will also include the lay-bys sections and we ask that residents & commuters refrain from parking within these lay-by sections prior to works commencing on the Sunday. If vehicles are parked within the area, operatives will be asking residents to relocate until such section is repaired. If contact cannot be made to the owner of the vehicle it may be at risk of being towed / removed to ensure the crew can progress the repair works.

On the 20<sup>th</sup> March, daytime works will begin on the inner ring of Freedom Bridge RAB. The roundabout will remain open, however the inner most lane will be subject to a lane closure to enable safe working. These civils works include replacement of any damaged kerbing within the inner ring and installation of additional cast iron bollards within the verge to prevent further overrunning damage. These works are predicted to last 5 working days however the lane closure will stay in place 24/7 from the 20<sup>th</sup> March to the 24<sup>th</sup> March.

Finally, once all weekend working is completed at North End & the civils work is completed to the RAB, will we move onto the resurfacing works at Freedom Bridge RAB. These works will require a full closure of the RAB and therefore works will be undertaken at night to prevent disruptions. This will be weekday working (Monday – Friday).

Lane Closure (Inner Ring) - Daytime Working - 20th March 2023 to 24th March 2023

• 08:00 to 17:00hrs

## FREEDOM BRIDGE RAB (A1101), WISBECH

Road Closure - Nightworks/Weekdays - 27th March 2023 to 07th April 2023

• 19:00 to 05:00hrs

As with all works there will be some noise associated and we will try to keep this to a minimum where possible. Some of the works are also weather dependant and if we are unable to undertake these tasks due to bad weather, we will look to return to site at a later date to complete when suitable.
