Vaccination of infants aged 6 months to 4 year olds who are immunosuppressed

The government has announced that a spring booster dose of the Covid-19 vaccine will be made available to individuals aged 6 months and over who are immunosuppressed as determined in the Green Book COVID-19: the green book, chapter 14a - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk).

National call letters from NHSE will go out to those patients on the immunosuppressed clinical list in the coming days letting them know that they are eligible for a booster dose of the COVID-19 vaccine.

The NHS North West London COVID-19 website is now fully up to date with the listings of confirmed vaccination centres and pharmacy sites within each borough, where people can book or walk-in for their COVID-19 booster vaccination (please note that all sites do not offer vaccination to children). 
Actions required by all NWL GP practices

Locally there are additional crucial steps that are required by all NWL GP practices to ensure that all immunosuppressed individuals are **identified and contacted** to receive a booster during the Spring 2024 Campaign.

Step 1 – IDENTIFICATION of individuals aged 6 months and over who are immunosuppressed


Practices should undertake local searches **(shared below)** within their GP IT systems (i.e. S1 or EMIS) to search for immunosuppressed patients and draw up a list of those who are eligible using Green Book definitions <u>COVID-19</u>: the green book, chapter 14a - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)

SystmOne: COVID-19 Spring Booster 2024 - Search location




EMIS: COVID-19 Spring Booster 2024 - Search location

Step 2 - INVITATION of individuals aged 6 months and over who are immunosuppressed

Once patient has been identified, practices should contact the individual and invite them to be vaccinated at one of the active sites in NWL. Please refer to NWL website for list of participating sites. https://www.nwlondonicb.nhs.uk/your-health-services/Covid-19/where-get-your-vaccine

Alternatively, immunosuppressed patients **over** 5 years old can be directed to the National Booking Service (NBS) online using this link: https://www.nhs.uk/nhs-services/covid-19-vaccination-services/book-covid-19-vaccination/

This is the priority group for vaccination and should be contacted immediately. Healthcare teams should use the opportunity to ensure that the child is up to date with their routine vaccinations.

Vaccination of infants aged 6 months to 4 year olds who are immunosuppressed

(note: over 5 years old can book an appointment via NBS)

In NWL, parents will be able to book a vaccination appointment for infants aged 6 months to 4 year olds who are immunosuppressed either at CP House or Brent Civic centre.
