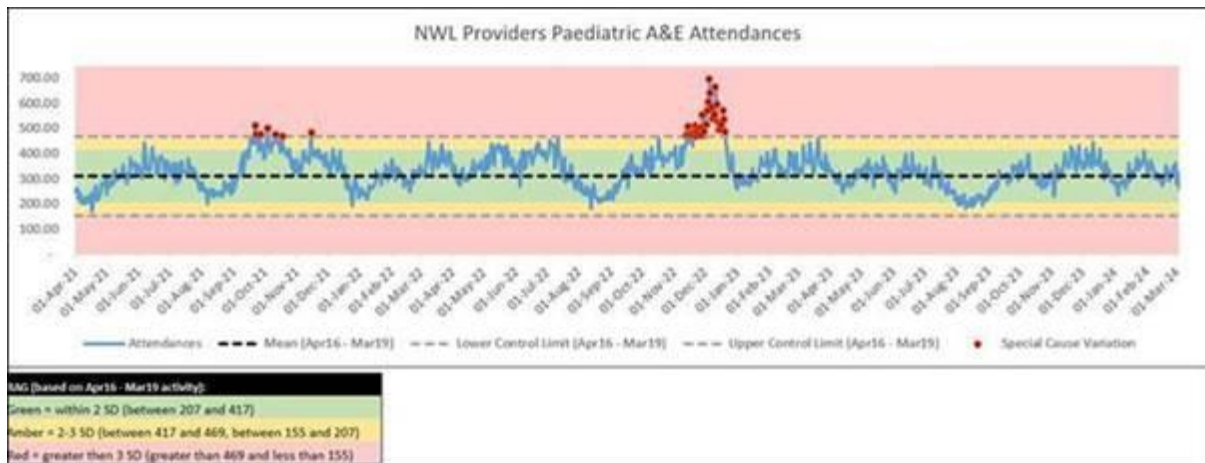

Paediatric A&E data trends

A&E attendances remain slightly below the pre-COVID average (Apr-19 to Mar-19) and continue to follow the same pattern as 2022 with a slight rise.

Key Points:

- In week 9, influenza and COVID-19 activity decreased across most indicators. Respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) activity remained low with indications of further decreases across some indicators
- A&E attendances are currently slightly below pre-COVID average (Apr-19 to Mar-19) and 2023 levels.
