BREAST SCREENING FOR TRANS AND NON-BINARY PEOPLE

- Any registered females (as on NHS spine) will automatically be invited for screening.
- Anybody who is not registered as female will **not be** automatically invited for screening (this is a limitation of the IT system).
- The NHS guidance https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/nhs-population-screening-information-for-trans-people since January 2023 for those in the screening age group (50-71):
 - who are registered male but born female who still have breast tissue (either because they have not undergone surgery or have residual breast tissue after surgery)
 - 2. those who are registered male but have undergone hormonal treatment and have breast tissue secondary to hormonal stimulation.

to be referred by their GPs to their local symptomatic breast unit - https://www.london-breastscreening.org.uk/home.aspx for equivalent NHSBSP screening (i.e 3 yearly between 50 -71).
