- Put a stop to stigma and discrimination
- Stop preventable deaths from HIV-related causes
- Work to improve the health, quality of life and well-being of people living with HIV across the capital

### PRIMARY CARE PLAYS A CRUCIAL PART IN ACHIEVING THESE GOALS

We will offer support with:

- Education and learning events with updates on HIV and the effects of multimorbidity and ageing
- Clinical resources to aid preventative care for people living with HIV, for example changes to vaccination schedules, and statins for CVD prevention
- Working with secondary care to identify and accurately code diagnoses of HIV and medications to improve care
- Collaborative working between primary and secondary care and HIV community organisations
- Increasing testing for HIV in primary care
