The analysis is the first of its kind to map the full patient pathway, highlighting gaps in patient journeys as represented by electronic medical records and the NICE guidelines.

We welcome attendance from people working in general practice with an interest in mental health care or use of electronic medical records to explore and understand healthcare delivery and outcomes. While our work focuses on North West London, our approach can be applied to other settings.
