Home Service for babies on the hep B pathway

A new home service for babies on the hep B pathway started in September 2024. It is already making a difference to the families of these babies. The home service liaises with the families directly to provide the hep B four-week dose, the one year booster dose, and the Dried Blood Spot test all at home.

Childhood immunisation payments

In the <u>letter</u> sent to general practice on 27 February 2025, reference was made to childhood immunisation payments being uplifted to £12.06. The work to update CQRS will be completed by late April ahead of the first data extraction and calculation in May. Commissioners and practices can offer and accept the services and be assured that CQRS will correctly reflect the new payment value when payment calculations start.

NWL Early Years

The evaluation report on Early Years work across Brent, Ealing and Harrow is attached for sharing more widely. It is a detailed document that captures the huge amount of work and investment by partners and stakeholders. Working at a hyperlocal level they have built an evidence base for working in a more targeted, population health driven, collaborative and integrated way. For those short on time the Executive Summary section is a good place to go to for an overview of the work, key findings and recommendations followed by Professor Mitch Blair's conclusion and reflective note.


