Across the UK, a greater proportion of ECGs are now being acquired and interpreted within the primary care community. Whilst the benefits for patients are obvious, there is a need to ensure any ECG undertaken in primary care is interpreted by practitioners who have received high quality, accredited training.

This ECG Masterclass has been designed by a GP and Cardiologist specifically to address the needs of front-line clinicians. North West London ICB CP-IS Phase 2 Training Sessions

CPIS – Child Protection Information System

- CP-IS is a secure digital system that shares information between social care and healthcare organisations about unborn babies and children who are subject to a child protection and those children who are children in care.
- CP-IS Phase 1 is being used by healthcare staff in unscheduled healthcare settings across England.
- Accessing CP-IS alerts healthcare staff to children identified as vulnerable and at risk of harm and so plan care accordingly.
- Phase 2 is the extension of CP-IS to scheduled care settings – GP practices, CAMHS, SARCS, 0-19 services, termination of pregnancy services, community paediatrics and dentistry.

CP- IS Phase 2 Training Sessions Objectives for attendees:

- Understanding of how the CP-IS system works and interfaces with existing systems.
- Knowledge of how to access to CP-IS using National Care Record System (NCRS) including the smartcards / codes required.
- Signposting and the next steps to gaining access to CP-IS in your service.
