

Dear GP colleagues

Please find details of the North West London children and young people's diagnostic service for suspected asthma.

NWL children's asthma diagnostic service

NWL currently has two sites for asthma diagnostics for children and young people aged 5-17 years.

The service offers:

- Exhaled Nitric Oxide (FeNO) measurement
- Spirometry with bronchodilator response
- Skin prick testing (aeroallergens)
- Eosinophil count

Both sites are currently open to referrals from any patient in NWL who has **suspected asthma based on clinical history**.

- Willesden Community Diagnostic Centre: Based at Willesden Centre for Health in Brent
- Ealing Community Diagnostic Centre: Based at Ealing Hospital

eRS Referral details are on the referral form, entitled '**NWL CYP Community Diagnostic Centre (CDC) for Asthma**'.

Reports will be sent back to the referring clinician for the diagnosis to be made in conjunction with the clinical history.

If you are uncertain about any aspect of diagnosis or management you can join a monthly MDT drop-in run by a paediatric asthma specialist and share your case. These are held on the second Tuesday of every month at 1pm – see the joining link [Click here to join the meeting](#)
